The IFERC-CSC supercomputer (Helios) will be installed in IFERC site at Rokkasho, Japan before 1st January 2012. After the lighthouse projects and test runs until 31st March 2012, the normal operation of Helios will start from 1st April 2012 to 31st December 2016.

Now "Call for proposals for the use of the IFERC-CSC" is appearing in this web site, which invites to propose projects to be run on Helios. Projects shall be relevant to fusion development (ITER & BA) in the field of magnetic confinement. Proposals will be selected according to a peer review process defined by the Standing Committee.
